

Application Requirements

- * Official transcripts
- * GMAT or GRE score at the 50th percentile or higher (GMAT 570+, GRE 303+)
- * 2.75 or higher in the last 60 units, 3.0 or higher in last 30 units
- * 2 letters of recommendation
- * Resume
- * Statement of purpose (Why do you want to get an MBA? Why do you want to come to our program? What makes you an outstanding MBA candidate?)

International Applicants

Proof of English proficiency by completing the TOEFL or IELTS.TOEFL minimum scores of 550 paper-based test (PBT), 80 on internet-based (iBT), or 213 on the computer-based test (CBT). International English Language Testing System (IELTS) overall band score of at least a 6.5.
